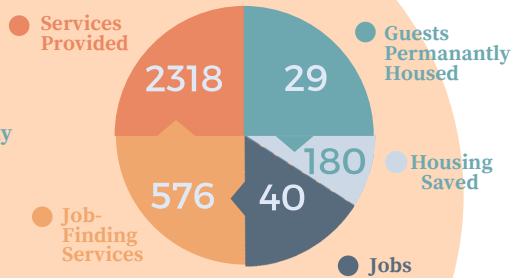
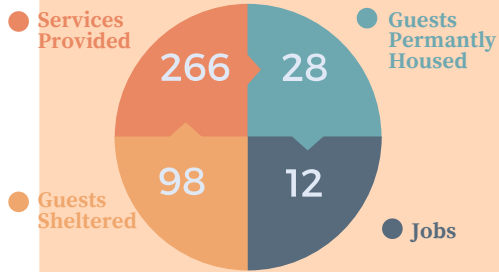

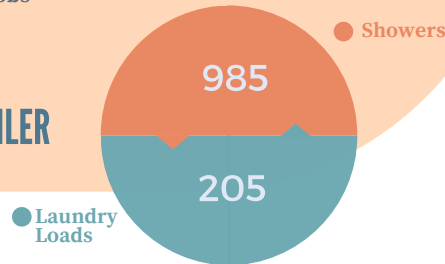

Staff and volunteers provide hope & encouragement, help clients navigate social services, provide life skills coaching, mental health & medical referrals, & offer case follow-up.

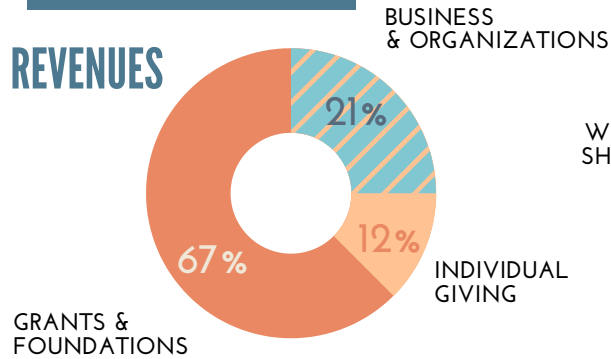

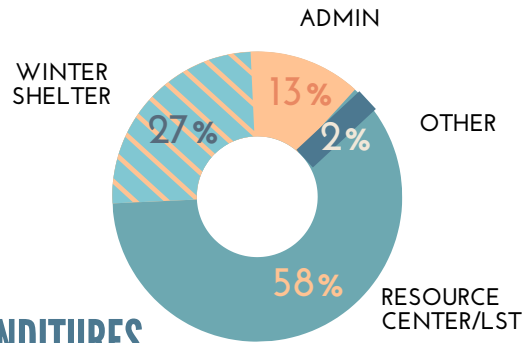
